



Considering Migrating From FlowForma On-Premise To FlowForma Cloud?

No doubt the benefits are there, so how do you quantify the migration task, so you can decide when the time is right?

In this guide, we'll look at some options ranging from simply using the document generation feature to output the form data in documents, to a full-blown migration of flows, forms, documents, templates, etc.

What You Need to Consider

There are three main things you need to consider when moving from an On-Premise installation of FlowForma Process Automation to the cloud. Is it just the flows that you've built that you need migrated, so you can start off fresh in a clean new environment? Do you need to migrate the forms created or have you generated documents that you can keep instead? You will also need to think about any overarching "customizations" that you've done.

1. Flows

Migrating flows is generally something every organization wants to export. FlowForma Process Automation has a flow export/import tool, to empower you to do this work, or we can do it for you, if you prefer. You will need to be aware of any lists or integrations with external apps, so that they can be reconfigured after the flow is moved.

2. Forms

Migrating forms is something you may or may not need to do, depending on the process you may not have a requirement to keep them, or you may even have documents generated, that you can keep for reference, instead of the forms.

3. Customizations

Every site is different, there will be changes that are specific to your company that will need to be recreated in the new Office 365 environment, from simple things like the general look and feel with company branding, to any custom rules/questions, or jobs that were created for your flows that we need to investigate for you.
